Ogier's star is shining!

Citroen Junior Team driver Sebastien Ogier took a first place on the premier stages of the first day and protected his place at the end of the day. He had a very successful performance at the first day including SSS and kept his place at the end.

Sebastien Ogier was the winner of the 5th stage of Rally of Turkey, Darlık. Behind him in one second difference Dani Sordo took place and Hirvonen took the third place. Ogier was again dominant at the 6th stage of Rally of Turkey, Karabeyli. Talented young driver took his second stage win. There was a two seconds difference between Ogier and Hirvonen. Dani Sordo took the third place at this stage.

The second run of the Bozgoça stage, Dani Sordo had won with his impressive performance and this was his first win at the Rally of Turkey. Petter Solberg took the second place and behind Solberg, Ogier was the third. Petter Solberg had the best second performance on the seventh stage and on the second run of the Hallı stage he took the first place as on the first run. There is a 0.1 second difference between Solberg and Hirvonen and after Hirvonen, Sordo took place with a 0.4 seconds gap.

The last stage of the day was held on Kadıköy, which was the Super Special Stage of Rally of Turkey. A high number of motorsport fans took their place on the tribunes. The excitement level of the event increased after the stage had started and spectators had taken many photos when the drivers had their amazing bridge jumping. The performance of the drivers was also lively broadcasted on TRT3. The winner of the Super Special Stage was Sebastien Loeb who known as professional asphalt surface driver. Behind Loeb, Ogier took a place with a 0.4 seconds difference. Ogier's bridge jumping was magnificent and caught the attention of the spectators. Petter Solberg took the third place on the crowded Super Special Stage.
